

**LIVERMORE STOCKMEN'S RODEO ASSOCIATION  
2010 WILD COW MILKING RULES & REGULATIONS**

**ELIGIBILITY:**

ALL contestants must provide proof of Health Insurance and age at the time of sign-up and at the rodeo.

**ENTRY FEES:**

Ninety dollars (\$90.00) per team.

**PURSE:**

The purse shall consist of all sponsor and Livermore Stockmen's Rodeo Association contributions & entry fees, less livestock costs (\$20.00 per team), and shall be paid to four (4) places in one (1) go round as follows: 40%, 30%, 20%, and 10%.

**SIGN-UPS:**

Board will announce date, time, & place of sign-ups.

1. Each applicant must be prepared to abide by all rules and regulations including Rules of Conduct and execute necessary releases for participation and proof of medical insurance.
2. All Wild Cow Milking Ropers and Muggers must be 18 years old or older.

**RULES OF COMPETITION:**

1. Two person Wild Cow Milking event, no outside assistance.
2. Must leave roping box with bottle from LSRA official. Must milk and finish with original bottle.
3. Cow's nose must cross score line, and flag is dropped, before cow can be roped.
4. If you call for the cow, she's yours!
5. Neck catch only – front leg out, one loop.
6. Cannot drag cow.
7. Rope must be clear of horse, saddle, arena panels and any other obstacles.
8. Cow must be standing on all 4 feet when milked.
9. Roper must milk cow and cross finish line.
10. Roper/Milker must hand bottle to Judge, Judge must be able to shake at least 1 drop of milk out of the bottle to complete mission.
11. **120 second time limit, until 4 places are filled – the longest time is the cut off.**
12. All ties will be settled with a coin toss and decision will be final.
13. All disputes will be settled by the LSRA Local Rules committee, all committee decisions are final.
14. All checks will be mailed the Wednesday following the rodeo.

**RULES OF CONDUCT:**

1. PRCA Dress Code-cowboy hat, long sleeve shirt, cowboy boots and long pants.
2. Must conduct your self in a professional manner. Any misconduct that is damaging to the Association or the sport of rodeo will result in automatic disqualification. The Livermore Stockmen's Rodeo Association Board of Directors may then issue a reprimand or a suspension indefinitely.
